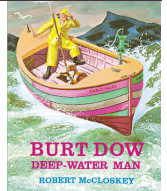

Live Theatre: **Blueberries For Sal & Burt Dow Deepwater Man**

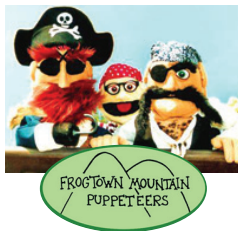
